



WOMEN EMPOWERMENT PROGRAM

[BEAUTICIAN TRAINING, COMPUTER TRAINING]

Our organization provided many type of skill development training to needy and deserving girls, like this year we trained at least above than hundred girls for beautician training, it helps them to be empower, be skilled, make financially strong.

Beauticians are professionals engaged in improving a client's appearance through hair care, nail, beauty and skin care. Beauticians can often specialize in certain areas such as nail art, makeup application, hair colour etc. A successful beautician knows that a fulfilling beauty career entails more than doing make-overs, performing extensive skin treatments and giving stylish haircuts. Being able to make clients feel good about themselves boosts their self-confidence and helps build strong relationships with them.

Apart from this we arranged free computer training classes for special community, schedule cast and schedule tribe, because they need it more, we provide training to all, but sc/st are our priority. Computers in education can be beneficial in several ways. They can increase the productivity of students by making tasks such as composing papers and research easier. They can make it easier for teachers to collect papers, grade them and send them back to students. Fifty plus lower cast students have been benefited from our computer training centre.













TOILET CONSTRUCTION FOR NEEDY PEOPLE


Toilet use is essential to the survival and development of all children in India and around the world, as exposure to human waste causes diseases such as diarrhoea. Diarrhoea and other sanitation related diseases can prevent children from being able to absorb the nutrients in their food, leading to undernutrition.


Toilets are crucial for the healthy development of people, not to mention children. So is sanitation – facilities and services for safe disposal of human urine and faeces includes maintaining hygiene through services such as garbage collection and wastewater disposal.

It found that in rural areas, there were 71.3% of households with access to a toilet - so less than three-quarters. The results appear at odds with another government report, the 2018-19 National Annual Rural Sanitation Survey, which showed that 93.3% of rural households had access to toilets. So we have constructed toilets for needy families this year.



















FARMER AWARENESS PROGRAM

Agriculture plays a vital role in the Indian economy. Over 70 per cent of the

rural households depend on agriculture.

Agriculture is an important sector of Indian economy as it contributes about 17% to the total GDP and provides employment to over 60% of the population.

Agriculture totally depend upon



farmers, A Farmer manages farms, ranches, greenhouses, nurseries, and other agricultural production organizations. Farmers are involved in planting, cultivating, performing post-harvest duties, overseeing livestock, and supervising farm labour depending on the type of farm. The basic objective of the farmer awareness programmes was to give exposure to the Indian farmers on various agricultural marketing reforms, modern marketing methods, direct marketing, group marketing, and interface with the experts of commodities specialist and marketing personnel, ware housing, pledge financing.

So we organized awareness programs for farmers, in which they can know about modern agriculture, how to grow more crops in limited fields etc. If a farmer developed then our society will also developed, If we developed more in industry, infrastructure but our country's spinal cord is Agriculture and Farmers are spinal cord of Agriculture.

HEALTH CHECKUP CAMPS

"Health is not valued... till sickness comes."

Our organization gives importance to phrase 'Health is Wealth' because if you are unhealthy then you can't able to do any work properly, and it's

harmful to do any work without giving your hundred percent.

We invite health experts and organize health check camps at various places for needy people of society and they get benefited regular health check up



camps like sugar checking, blood pressure checking, and cholesterol check up etc.

Also distribute some basic medicines to poor and needy people like fever tablets, cough syrups etc.

HIV/AIDS AWARENESS PROGRAM

HIV stands for human immunodeficiency virus. It harms your immune system by destroying the white blood cells that fight infection. This puts you at risk for serious infections and certain cancers. AIDS stands for acquired



immunodeficiency syndrome. It is the final stage of infection with HIV.

These diseases spread in youth mostly, so we arrange awareness camps, in which we invite our societies youths to participate for knowledge and also precaution and how to save from it awareness.

SENIOUR CITIZEN'S WELFARE PROGRAM

"People don't die of Old age... they die of Neglect."

Many of these elderlies suffer from mental disorders, with dementia and depression being the most common in their age group. Many also suffer from anxiety disorders with few inviting deaths for themselves from self-harm. Substance abuse is another problem they go through which is often overlooked or misdiagnosed.




Providing them good elderly care by you or with the help of professionals stops them from feeling isolated and depressed. You help continue to provide them a sense of community, a social life, which empowers and energizes them. Gain insight into their values. So, our team visit various old age homes and distribute blankets, dry foods, and other basic stationery, so that in this age, they have no family member with them, may be these things made them happy.

VOCATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM (KNITTING)

At present time in rural and urban areas all public need to be skilled in any filed, and now is the time of being self-dependent by small industries, homemade businesses and give contribution to developing Indian economy. So we spread knowledge about government schemes for backward people. In that knitting is a easy and profitable skill for women, Knitting is a method by which yarn is manipulated to create a textile or fabric; it is used in many types of garments. Knitting may be done by hand or by machine. Knitting creates stitches: loops of yarn in a row, either flat or in the round. There are usually many active stitches on the knitting needle at one time. In market now its demand is increasing, people show interest in handmade & beautiful things, So we provide training of knitting to many women till now and continuing.

Organization executed many other programs and people got benefited in large scale. Some information has also been recorded from different localities for future use.
